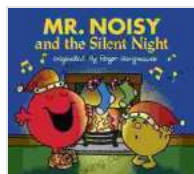
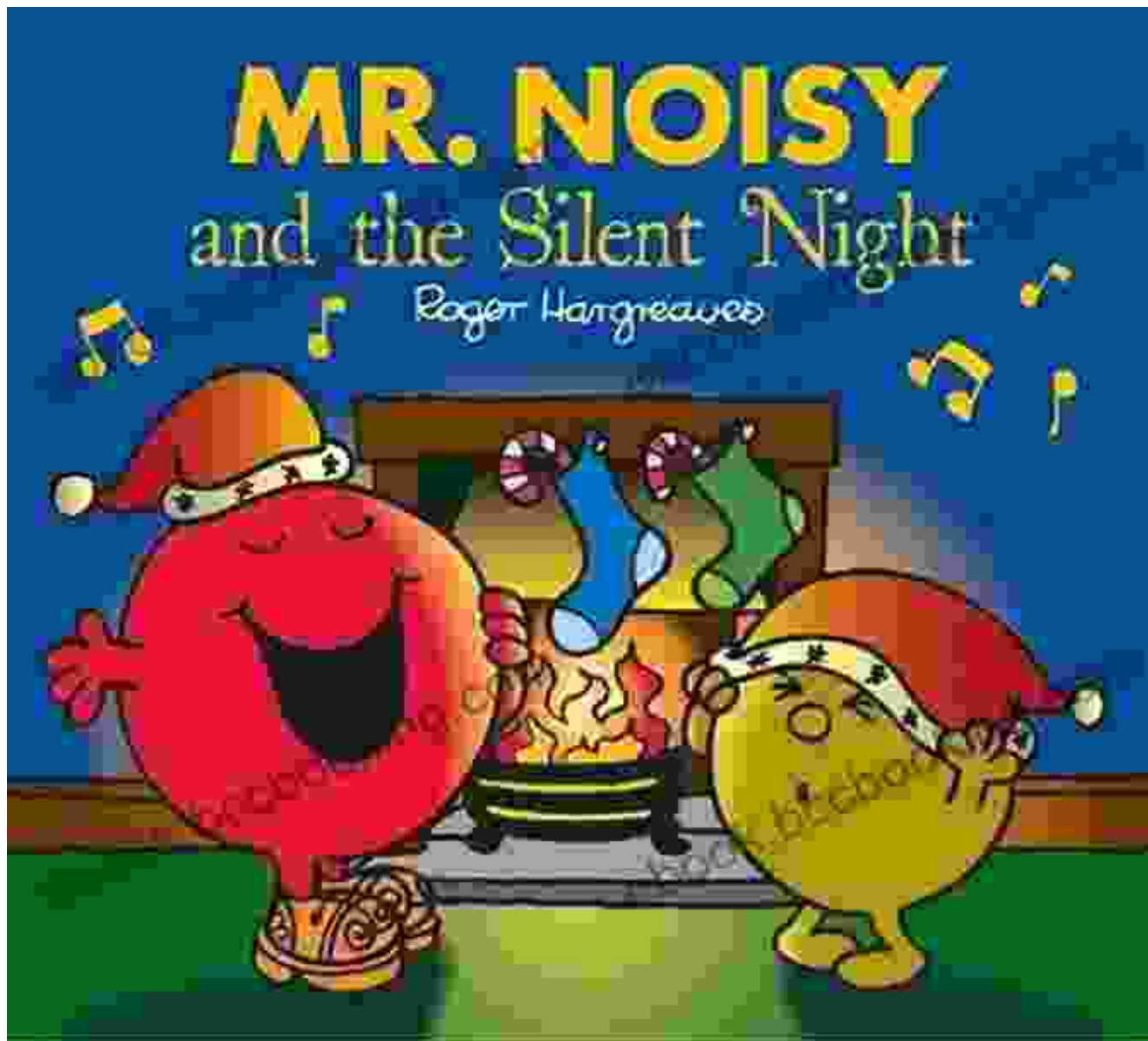

Hargreaves died in 1988, but his books continue to be enjoyed by children all over the world.

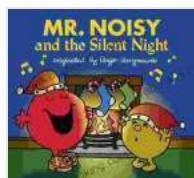

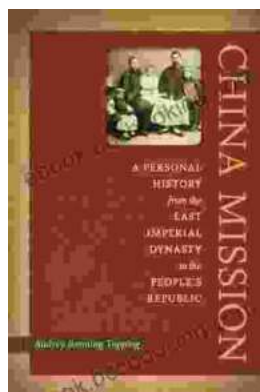
