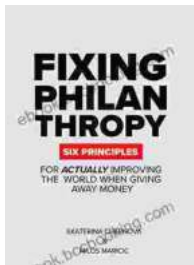
How to Get Started

No matter how much you give, you can make a difference. By following Singer's six principles, you can be sure that your money is being used to make the greatest possible impact.



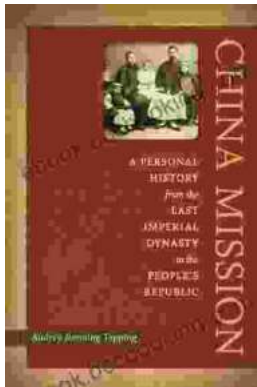
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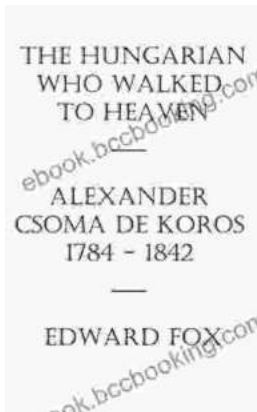
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
